

School Council Meeting

Date: Tuesday 2nd July

Review of year: School councillors thanked for their brilliant participations to school council this year. We discussed the successes of the school council this year: **Children in Need fundraising/ New Year's resolutions/ Comic Relief- red nose day/ Water bottle competition** (next time suggested that it could be announced more often in assembly to encourage more participants)/ **Traffic lights/ MP letter** (when she visits- Q&A session in classes?)/ **Labelled box for all of the school council sports equipment** in (to be taken onto the field when it is summer time. Play leaders to take out and organise games ie. for the parachute. School council to help younger members play are remind about tidying up).

Sports day feedback: The events of the day were discussed. Potted sports: All agreed that they enjoy the rotation activities, particularly the 'crazy catching' and the activities that prepare you for the afternoon eg. skipping. It was suggested that children could take water bottles around with them as some said they became thirsty long before the water station. It was also suggested that some activities could be varied – a yoga/chill out station was suggested and a trampoline station. It was also mentioned that it would be useful to have a cone marking where everyone should start on each station, netball hoops high and wellies big for younger ones and some sacks have holes. In the afternoon it was highlighted that there is a lot of waiting around. To address this it was suggested that KS1 and KS2 could do races on a different day from each other. This would also enable a break if needed – suggested as a possibility. There was an alternative suggestion of activities to be put on the save waiting around eg. skipping ropes on the playground/golden time in classroom/turns of trim trail. If done the traditional way KS2 suggested that they might also be able to sit in the shade. Potentially under the trees at the back which would also mean more people would be able to spectate the races. Additionally children would enjoy having a three-legged race, a parent's race and a shuttle run added the events of the day.
